In the past few days, I've taught a machine learning algorithm how to write in the style of <u>Harry Potter</u>, <u>Hamilton (the musical)</u>, and <u>HBO's Silicon Valley</u>. The mostly non-sensical, occasionally human-like, topically-flavored writing seems to be amusing not only to me, but to many others.

HYPOTHESIS: If I download an Al algorithm and feed it all my poetry from high school and college, then a new poem in my style will be generated.



# **EXPERIMENT:**

Download Python 3.6 and TensorFlow.

Create a master text document containing the 112 poems written between 2001-2007 (senior year of high school through 1st year in NYC post undergrad at University of Miami).

Poems are then generated by the model by randomly selecting a word in the dataset and following it with the predicted next word.

The model runs 10 times creating 10 machine generated poems.

Share best results.



### **RESULTS:**

CONTROL POEM: circa 2002 while at University of Miami

Generated Poem #10: 60 words

# CONCLUSIONS:

The algorithm was unable to recreate a poem in my style.

This is due to either a poor algorithm, or a poor dataset.

I assume the dataset is the main problem as my poetry wasn't strict with grammar conventions and structure.

Future experiments should use a more consistent and larger dataset.
